

Tour of the British Library

Wednesday 7th February at 11 am.



The visit to the British Library in September was oversubscribed so TASHH has arranged a second fascinating guided tour for our members. We will be visiting the British Library and will learn about its history, its collection and its architecture during a tour of the public areas of the Library. We will visit the Viewing Gallery and book handling room where you can see some of the Reading Rooms and find out how books are stored, accessed and delivered. We will then be introduced to some of the most iconic items held within the British Library collections. Find out more about the King's Library (George III's library) and the Klencke Atlas, the second-largest atlas in the world. We will also visit the Sir John Ritblat Gallery, where over 200 of the library's greatest treasures are displayed.

There are three cafes and a restaurant in the Library building where we can go and have lunch if we want
There are only 15 places so book early.

The cost of the visit is £22.00 (£24.00 non-members) per person.
