

Guided walk and talk on Constable's Hampstead

Wednesday 8th June 2022 at 10 am



Constable is one of our most revered English artists. We are giving you an opportunity to walk in Constable's footsteps to see where he lived, worked and painted his wonderful landscapes. You will even see where he is buried. Estelle Lovatt, an art historian and Constable enthusiast, will lead the walk and tell us about Constable's life, his wife and his family. Estelle will tell us about his dislike of Turner and his relationship with the Royal Academy and describe how he developed his love of painting en plein air. She will bring alive everything you wanted to know about Constable.

There are only **10 places** on this walk, and you are advised to book early. Estelle will take us on a gentle two-hour walk starting at Whitestone Pond and finishing at the Church of St John in Hampstead, during which she will show us hidden areas of Hampstead and where Constable got his inspiration.
