Nestled in the heart of Covent Garden, the iconic Theatre Royal Drury Lane has survived tragedy, fire, bankruptcy and even murder.

Come on a private tour that will take you on a magical journey through the theatrical history of the Theatre Royal Drury Lane, a Grade 1 listed building. This is the fourth theatre that has occupied this site since 1663 and it is the oldest theatre in the world that has remained on the same site.

Immerse yourself in the birthplace of musicals, modern pantomime and moving scenery in this beautifully renovated theatre

If we want lunch afterwards, there are numerous restaurants in the area where we can meet and eat
