From its conception Spencer House was recognized as one of the most sumptuous private residences ever built in London and it is of unique importance in the history of English architecture. It has one of the finest neo classical interiors in Europe. It is the ancestral home of Princess Diana, the late Princess of Wales, a member of the Spencer family

We are offering you a guided tour of this iconic building and the opportunity to visit a really important house which is one of the few great London houses that has remained intact. We will also learn the history of the family that lived here
