

Zoom live walking tour of **Venice**

Wednesday 23rd June at 4pm



Venice is hot and normally very crowded in the summer but we at TASHH have arranged a walking tour in the cool of the late afternoon when the tourists have gone to change and have their cocktails. We are going to Cannaregio, the northernmost of the six historic sestieri or districts of Venice. The canal running through the area was the main route to the city before railways. The area along the Grand Canal to the Rialto Bridge had grand palazzos but Cannaregio was largely a working-class area. It was the gated Jewish ghetto for 270 years until Napoleon conquered the Venetian Republic in 1797 and opened the gates allowing the citizens to live where they wanted. The area boasts the Ca d'Oro Palace and numerous craft shops in Strada Nova and is a very popular area away from the centre

This is a unique opportunity for a private live Zoom guided walk around Cannaregio with a Venetian tourist guide, Luisella, Romeo, who is keen to share the delights of Cannaregio with you. The visit will take place on Zoom on Wednesday 23rd June 2021 at 4pm, to avoid the worst of the heat and crowds. It will last approximately 1 hour.
